

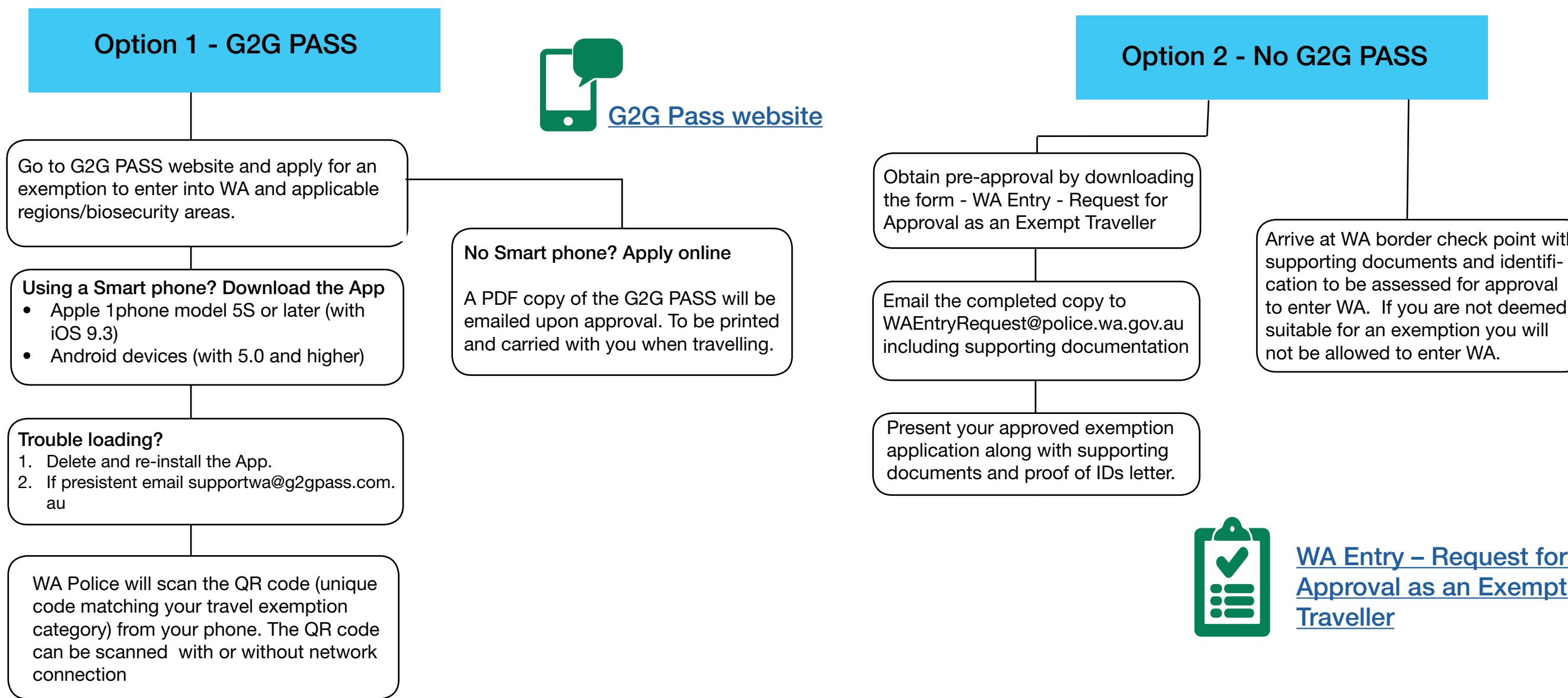
Freight and Logistics Movement Control

Are you planning to travel into W.A. and/or through regional W.A? Strict border controls are in place to limit the spread of COVID-19. You cannot enter WA or its regions unless you have been granted an exemption to travel.

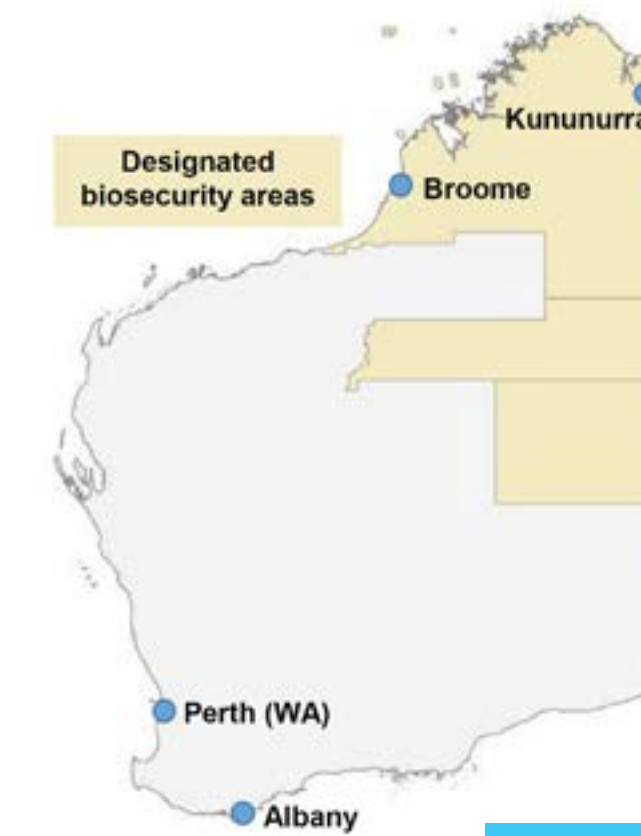

Travel into Biosecurity Area

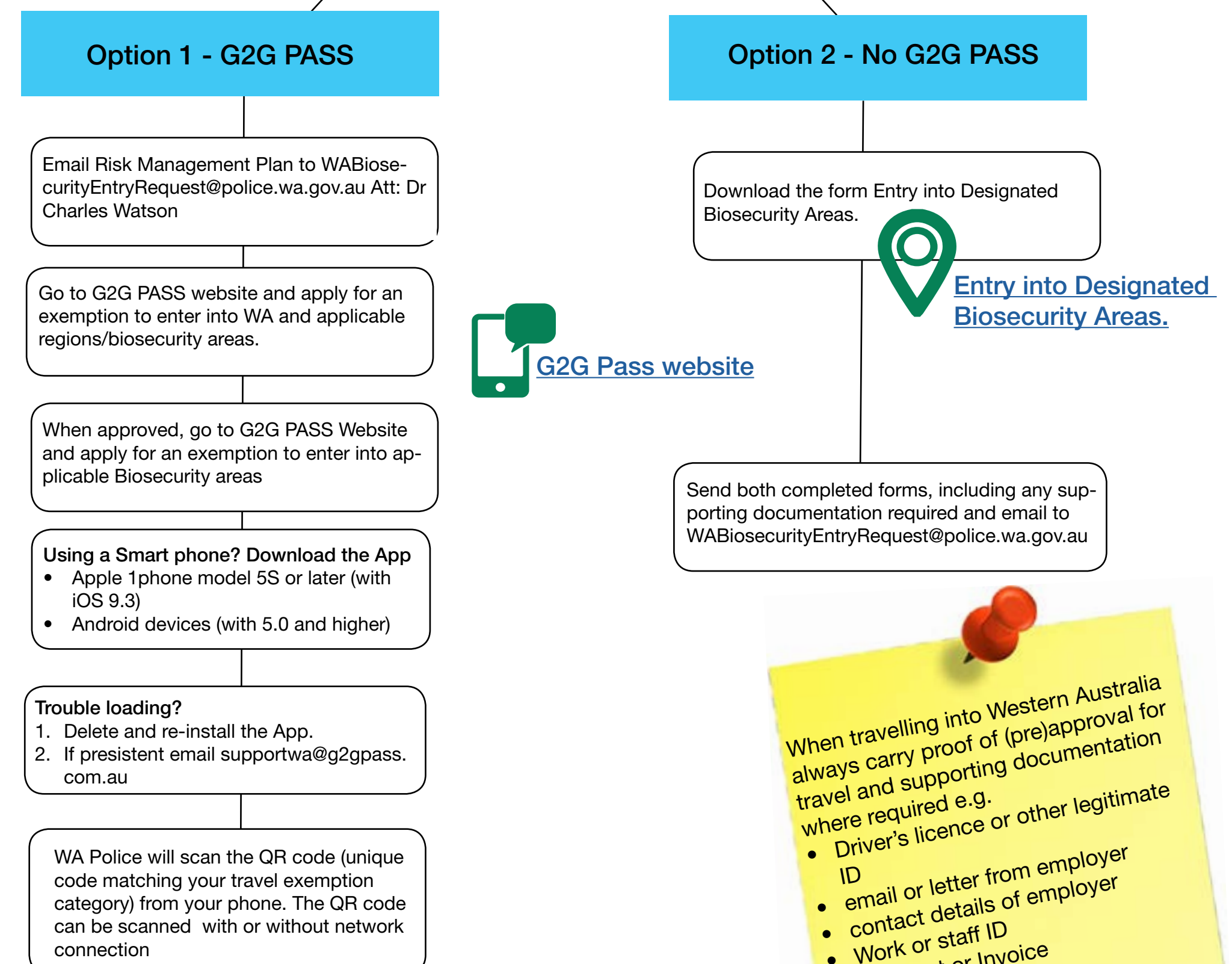


Note: you will not be granted entry to WA through a Biosecurity area (e.g. Kununurra) without an approved Risk Management Plan.



For for travel into a biosecurity region, if a company is applying on the paper-based system they need to apply for entry each time they travel thought the Kimberley. If they apply through G2G for the Kimberley they need to nominate the dates of travel - it cannot be an open-ended permit. See our border resources page for more information on this.

When travelling into Western Australia always carry proof of (pre)approval for travel and supporting documentation where required e.g.

- Driver's licence or other legitimate ID
- email or letter from employer
- contact details of employer
- Work or staff ID
- Contract or Invoice
- Uniform
